40 varieties of apples will be available to taste at the Lathcoats Farm Apple Day event on October 24th 2009 between 10 am and 4 pm. A range of single variety juices, all made from apples grown on the farm, will also be available to taste.

Some of the region's best food producers will join the celebrations, showcasing the finest beef, pork, chicken, pies, organic vegetables, cooking oil, ice cream, beer, cider and wine. All produced to the highest standards by small family businesses.

Bring and share your favourite recipes in the recipe marquee – bring a sample to taste and a copy of the recipe to share with others.

Try your hand at modelling and painting your own clay apples with the Clay Workshop, archery, donkey rides and ride on tractors.

We will also be looking for a winner in the Longest Apple Peel competition. In previous years we have produced a national winner!

Presentations will be made to the winners of the *Essex Chronicle/Lathcoats Farm Great Essex Apple Recipe Competition* and the *Apple Day Poetry Competition for Apple Shaped Poems about Apples*.

Admission is free and limited parking is available at the farm and across the road at Abercorn Garden Centre. Cyclists and walkers welcome, and the number 42 bus stops right outside the farm.
